Trail Etiquette

- 1. Clean up after your horse. Do not clean out your trailer in the State Park.
- Avoid muddy and wet areas when possible, but do not go off trail unless a muddy stretch poses a significant safety hazard.
- 3. Only ride at the level of the least experienced rider in your group.
- 4. Do not let horse graze on trees or brush.
- 5. Share the road/trail: be mindful of other users such as bikers and pedestrians.
- 6. LEAVE NO TRACE. What you pack in, you should pack out.
- 7. Observe park wildlife from a distance and never feed the animals.
- 8. Always take a map and have a plan.
- 9. Don't crowd the horse in front of you. Keep a horse length distance between riders.
- 10. Follow all signage and postings.

Park Rules

- 1. Only ride on designated trails that are appropriately marked with red blazes.
- 2. Open fires are not permitted on state park property.
- 3. There is no overnight camping.
- 4. Alcohol is not permitted.



Equestrian trails are in the southwest and east sides of the park. Riding is limited to designated trails and roadsides throughout the park.

Designated equestrian trails are blazed in red.
